



Douglas County Chamber Foundation Leadership Scholarship

The Chamber Foundation offers two scholarships to local graduating *high school seniors*: one \$1,000.00 scholarship and one \$500.00 scholarship. These scholarships will be awarded to high school seniors exemplifying outstanding leadership qualities. Qualifications are as follows:

- ⇒ Student must be a graduating senior living in Douglas County;
- ⇒ Student must have a cumulative 3.5 grade point average or higher;
- ⇒ Student must plan to attend an institution of higher learning;
- ⇒ Student needs to have demonstrated leadership experience through school, community activity and/or work experience;
- ⇒ Student must submit two recommendation letters, one by a representative from school and one by a member of the business community; and
- ⇒ Student must write a 500 word essay on a leader he/she admires and the leadership qualities that leader exemplifies.

The winning students will be selected by the Scholarship Committee of the Douglas County Chamber Foundation. Applications may be hand delivered or mailed and must be received by **5:00 p.m. on Wednesday, March 15, 2017**. Emailed or faxed applications will not be accepted. - ⇒ Completed application form;
- ⇒ One official copy of the student transcripts;
- ⇒ One letter of recommendation from a school representative;
- ⇒ One letter of recommendation from a business representative; and
- ⇒ A 500 word essay on a leader he/she admires and the leadership qualities that leader exemplifies.
