

Legislative Update – Week 1



The first week of the 2019 Session was marked by a number of events. The Governor, Lt. Governor, and all of Georgia's Constitutional Officers were sworn in last Monday at 2pm at the McCamish Pavilion on Georgia Tech's campus.

On Thursday, Governor Kemp laid out his agenda and some budget priorities before a joint session of the House and Senate. Speaking about continued economic development successes, teacher raises, the budget reserve, school safety, and movement toward a Medicaid waiver. On Thursday night the Kemp family and the Georgians First Committee hosted the Inaugural Gala. The event was held at the State Farm Arena and attended by elected officials and citizens across the State.
